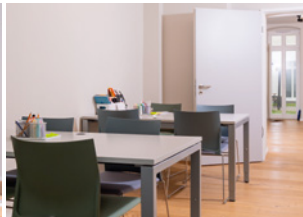
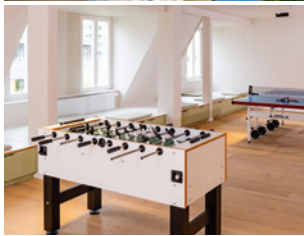

At Oberberg Clinics, we provide treatment for patients with private health insurance, direct payers and „Beihilfeberechtigte“ (in Germany, „Beihilfe“ refers to a government allowance for healthcare costs provided to certain public sector employees, e.g. civil servants, judges, soldiers. People who are „beihilfeberechtigt“ are entitled to receive partial reimbursement of their medical expenses from the government.). In certain cases, we can also admit patients with statutory health insurance. If you're interested, we're happy to advise you and your parents at any time – by phone or in person by appointment – about admission procedures, therapy concepts, the focus of treatment, and our facilities.
